MINGEI: The Beauty of Everyday Things
200-yen discount available on same-day tickets for visitors wearing a *yukata*
Press Release Days: Saturdays, Sundays, and holiday (Aug. 11) in August 2023

Nakanoshima Museum of Art, Osaka (located in Kita-ku, Osaka City, and headed by Director Sugaya Tomio) is currently holding the exhibition MINGEI: The Beauty of Everyday Things until September 18, 2023.

A “YUKATA de MINGEI” discount—a 200-yen discount on same-day tickets—is available for visitors to the exhibition wearing a *yukata* on Saturdays and Sundays in August 2023, and on the public holiday, August 11. Yukata is an informal cotton kimono with a close affinity to mingei craftwork. August is a time when many people wear yukata for summer festivals and fireworks shows.

The exhibition presents Aichi yukatas made of traditional tie-dyed Arimatsu Narumi Shibori cotton cloth and Okinawan kimonos made of colorful dyed *bingata* fabrics and *basho* cloth made of banana leaf fibers, whose very appearance makes one feel cooler. Why not come see the MINGEI exhibition wearing a yukata, which adds color to summertime in Japan and expresses part of the unique beauty of Japan?
