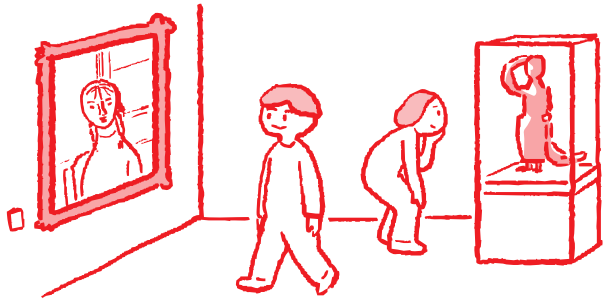


Good manners in the galleries

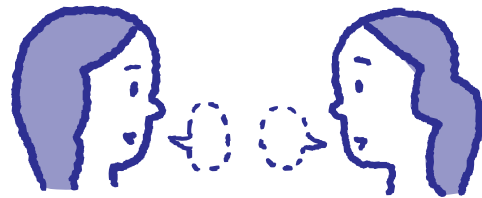
Keep your distance

Don't get too close to the exhibits and display cases while you are looking at them. Put large bags or other luggage in a locker.



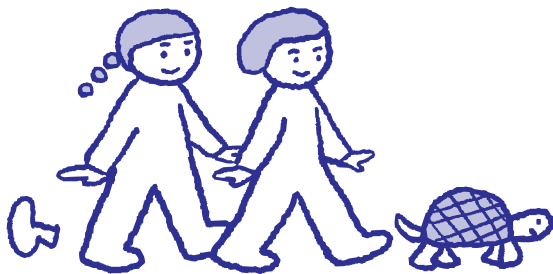
Keep your voice down

Other people are looking at the exhibits, too. Take care not to talk too loudly.



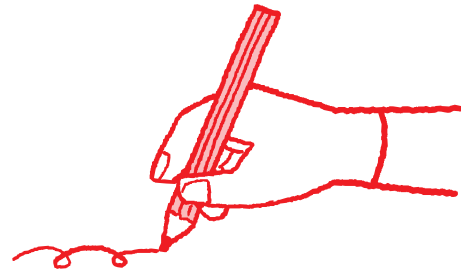
Walk slowly

If you run around, you could run into someone else and hurt them. You might break an exhibit, too.



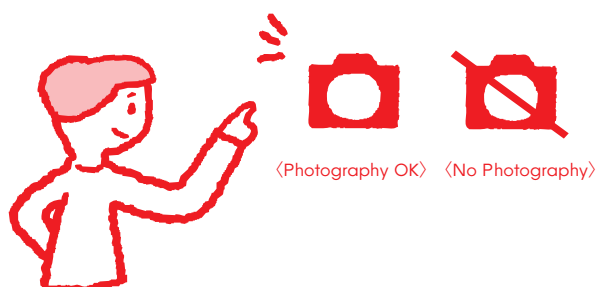
Use a regular pencil

The lead from a mechanical pencil, a colored pencil, or the ink from a pen could damage the exhibits.



Read the signs

You can take photos in some exhibitions, but not others. Check the information sign at the entrance.



No food or drink

Food and drink make mold grow and attract insects. Mold and insects can damage or destroy the exhibits.
