The exhibition shop for *Celebrating the Museum's First Anniversary Saeki Yuzo : Emerging from the Urban Landscape* that is currently running at Nakanoshima Museum of Art, Osaka, is selling merchandise that is only available at this venue in Osaka.

The merchandise is adorned with illustrations by popular illustrator Matsumoto Seiji based on Postman, a work that is being exhibited at this exhibition.

<= Name stamps (hanko) sporting a variety of different names cost 880 yen each, including tax. In addition to names, the selection of 249 stamps includes words and phrases in the Osaka dialect of Japanese, such as "Ooki ni" (Thank you), in honor of Saeki Yuzo, who was from Osaka.

=> The gauze handkerchief costing 770 yen, including tax, is an item for everyday use sporting a cute image of Postman. The design is suitable for both children and adults, making it an ideal souvenir to bring back from the exhibition.



<= This A6-sized ring-bound notepad costing 770 yen, including tax, is easy to carry around, and fits nicely in your bag.
